

Person who have signed a civil partnership (PACS) with a French citizen – LTV-RP

Please prepare 2 samples of each document : 1 original + 1 copy

- Two long stay visa application form original dated and signed by visa applicant+ copy
- OFII form duly completed (original + copy)
- Two identity photos 2 inches with clear background
- Passport original + copies of the first 5 pages of the passport, including all the pages which contains visas or stamps
- Hukou original + copy and translation of all the pages which contain information about the applicant and family members
- Original ID card + copy and translation (issued by competent authorities of Shanghai, Anhui, Jiangsu, Zhejiang province). If ID card issued by authorities of another province, resident permit issued by competent authorities of Shanghai, Anhui, Jiangsu, Zhejiang province + copy and translation
- recent certificate of commitment in a civil relationship with a French citizen (PACS) issued by the competent Family Court or French Consular authorities (original + copy)
- Cover letter from the applicant stating reasons of the visa application and means of living and accommodation during the stay in France (length of stay, financial resources, means of accommodation, private or family relationship in France, medical covering) original + copy
- Proof of accommodation (original + copy):
 - * Host ID copy
 - * lodging attestation signed by the host
 - * Host property ownership or lease contract copy
- Proof of regular and sufficient financial resources for the whole stay in France original + copy:
 - * International credit card + bank reports
 - * savings account reports
 - * if necessary, host financial support guarantees
- if the visa applicant wish to stay in France less than 12 months, copy of the round-trip flight ticket booking. Otherwise (if the applicant wish to stay in France more than one year), copy of the one-way flight ticket booking
- Insurance original + copy and translation

NB : the LTV-RP issued will mention “Visitor” (“Visiteur”) which will not allow the holder to work in France. As a consequence, holder of such a visa is advised to contact, upon his/her arrival in France, the local relevant Prefecture in order to get a resident permit mentioning “Private and family life” (“Vie privée et familiale”) which will allow him/her to work in France.
